LED Leisure is a charitable trust, managing a large number of facilities throughout East Devon and South Somerset on behalf of the respective local authorities, as well as numerous community and health projects.

East Devon District Council leisure facilities and equipment assets are leased to us, and we now manage many of the activities previously operated through the Council's Leisure and Lifestyles Team. We also operate Goldenstones Leisure Centre, St Michael's Hall and Wincanton Sports Centre on behalf of South Somerset District Council.

The Social Enterprise Mark criteria includes a requirement for all applicants and renewing Mark Holders to provide at least three 'social impact statements', which illustrate how they are striving to meet their social/environmental objectives.

Below are examples of how **LED Leisure** is making a mark, striving to make a difference to our local communities:

Pioneering sports and wellbeing in the community

As part of our commitment to the communities we serve, we have established a thriving Outreach section, whereby we enable, create and support community sports and health development projects.

These projects can greatly vary in what they offer, this could be walking or skateboarding, or we even offer our group exercise classes such as Zumba.

Engaging disadvantaged members of the community

LED has provided discounted activities to socially, economically and health disadvantaged members of the community.

For example, Our Passport To Leisure (PTL) scheme provides discounts to individuals and families on means tested benefits.

We have also linked up with FORCE Cancer Charity to provide an 8 week physical activity programme for people to keep active during and after their cancer treatment.

Investing in improving sports and leisure facilities

LED invested £1.5m in improving community sports and leisure facilities in 2015.

As well as leisure centres, LED also manages parks, a 3G pitch, and The Pavilion and Ocean in Exmouth.
