We are responsible for assessing applications for the internationally recognised Aspiring Social Enterprise Mark, Social Enterprise Mark, Social Enterprise Gold Mark and the Disability Employment Mark.

We are committed to safeguarding your privacy, and will collect and use the personal data that you share with us transparently, honestly and fairly.

What information do we collect about you?
